ABOUT

Naturopathy Day is observed every year in the country on 18th November, the day on which Mahatma Gandhi become a Life Member of the Nature Cure Foundation Trust and signed the deed. Gandhiji is considered the founding figure of Naturopathy in India, as it was largely through his efforts that this practice which originated in Europe became popular in India.

The event is celebrated by organizing naturopathy awareness camps, workshops, seminars and conferences across the country. Several Naturopathy hospitals, organizations and BNYS degree colleges conduct a weeklong awareness and medical camps for the general public on this day.


This year CCRYN, New Delhi and National Institute of Naturopathy, Pune are jointly organizing the Naturopathy day celebrations in Pune Maharashtra between November 16th to 19th 2022. The intercollegiate sports and cultural events are being held on 16th and 27th by NIN and international conference is being held on 18th and 19th November by CCRYN. The theme for this year's Naturopathy day celebration is "Naturopathy an Integrative Medicine" where one can use various treatments and therapies under naturopathy for preventing disease and its complications and maintaining health and wellbeing.

NIN Pune is organizing several events including Intercollegiate competitions among undergraduate Naturopathy colleges, followed by workshops and camps throughout the year.

CCRYN is organizing for the first time an "International Conference on Naturopathy" in association with World Naturopathy Federation. This conference will see students, teachers, researchers, practitioners and academicians in this field deliberating on the opportunities and challenges in this sector and exploring avenues for growth of this sector.

REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

Last date for online registration is 10/11/2022. Registration for the conference is on a first come first serve basis and will be done online only.

Individual Registration

Online Individual registration can be done through www.naturopathyday.in. Those wishing to submit abstracts (Students/faculty) should do individual registration only even if they are representing an institute, others may do through group registration.

Institute/group registration

Students and faculty registering through college or institute should select "bulk/group registration" instead of "individual registration" and give the bank details of their respective institutions they are representing. They should register through www.naturopathyday.in select bulk registration.

Spot Registration:

Spot registrations will only be entertained subject to availability of space.

Once registered online you will receive a confirmation number. Please bring confirmation number on the day of registration.

This conference will have key note presentations, Invited presentations, and panel discussion session. Free paper sessions will also be held as parallel sessions for both Poster and Oral paper Sessions. Interested Candidates are advised to submit their abstracts online at www.naturopathyday.in. The abstracts will be shortlisted for poster and oral presentations by a jury. A maximum of 100 abstracts will be shortlisted for poster presentation and a maximum of 20 abstracts will be shortlisted for oral presentations. There will be First, Second and Third prizes for both poster and oral presentations. Those abstracts not selected for Oral or poster presentations will be published in the proceedings of the conference. The guidelines for poster and oral presentations are as follows:

Guidelines for submission of abstracts:

Article title. The title provides a distilled description of the complete article and should be concise and include information about the study design, outcome measures, intervention and population under study.

Abstract Body: Each abstract should not be more than 300 words. All abstracts should be structured having Background, Methods, Results and Conclusion. The abstract should be a structured abstract and provide the context or background for

the study and should state the study's purpose, basic procedures (selection of study participants, settings, measurements, analytical methods), main findings/results (giving specific effect sizes and their statistical and clinical significance, if possible), and principal conclusions. It should emphasize new and important aspects of the study or observations, note important limitations, and not over interpret findings. Clinical trial abstracts should conform to CONSORT group checklist

Oral Presentation:

Abstracts selected for oral presentation will be asked to present on 19th afternoon in the conference. Shortlisted candidates will be intimated earlier via mail regarding the presentation. The candidates should prepare a power point and send the same to the organizers via mail before the presentation i.e by 15th November 2022. Candidates who have not submitted will not be allowed to participate in oral paper sessions. Each presenter has 7 minutes to present followed by 3 minutes for discussion and Q&As. The decision of the judges is final and candidate will give undertaking to that effect.

Poster Presentation

Abstracts selected for poster will be intimated and poster guidelines will be circulated later.

Systematic review workshop and meta analysis

Institutes shall be required to nominate suitable candidates for the workshop on systematic reviews. They will have to mail the names of candidates, gender, year, UG/PG/Faculty, mobile/email id to workshop.icn@gmail.com. Attendance to this workshop is on nomination basis from Institutes only. Candidates will be selected based on their academic and research credentials. Opportunity will be given to all institutions and each institution can send maximum 5 names. The workshop will be for 150 people only on first come first serve basis.
